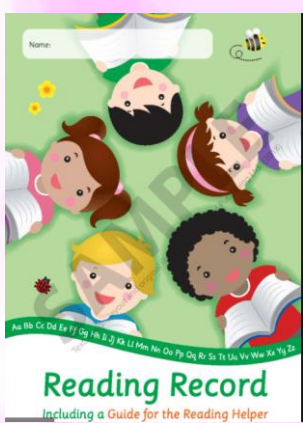

# Reading books

- Read every day for at least **10 minutes**
- Ask the children questions about what they have read as you go along
- Sound out any words using phonic sounds that the children are not sure of – phonic sound reminder on school website
- As reading develops encourage expression and fluency
- Record progress of reading reading record book
- Bring reading bag to school every day
- Look after reading books
- An adult or older sibling must sign to show they have read.



# Homework

## Homework



- Homework will be given every **Thursday** and due back the following **Tuesday**.
- Spellings sent out to be learnt for a test every Tuesday.
- Completion of homework recorded – this includes Reading, spellings and Timetable Rockstars.

# Year 2 SATs

- Children will complete the Year 2 SATs in the Summer term.
- These tests consist of Maths arithmetic and reasoning, Spellings, Grammar and Punctuation and two Reading papers.
- Although these tests are not mandatory, we will be sitting them for assessment purposes.
- We call these tests 'quizzes' when presenting them to the children and they will be completed in the classroom setting where the children feel most comfortable.

# PE



- Every **Wednesday**.
- Children come in their PE kits. This includes coloured house top, school hoodie, jumper or cardigan, jogging bottoms and trainers.
- PE will be done outside wherever possible.

## Swimming Pool

- The children will be at school after the October half term. Children must bring a swimming cap, towel, swimming costume or shorts. This needs to be in a bag clearly labelled with their name.

# Uniform

- Please ensure all uniform has your child's name clearly labelled. This makes it easier if uniform is misplaced or lost.
- Coats should be brought into school every day – we never know the ever-changing weather!

# Water bottles

- Important that the children bring their own labelled water bottle to school every day to help with hydration in class and keep contamination to a minimum
- No juice in bottles, just water
- Water bottles are kept in bottle holders attached to class chairs – measurements have been sent out.



# School Dinners

- These are to be ordered weekly online.
- Make sure the children know what the choices are and order something they like.
- Dinners are made to order



# Break time toast

- Toast can be ordered for morning break through parent pay
- This is done half termly
