HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Every school is required to have a written home-school agreement.

The home-school agreement explains the aims and values of our school and spells out the responsibilities of the school and your responsibilities and what is expected of your child.

The agreement is there so that both school and parents can work closely together to support your child through his/her school life.

You will be expected to sign the agreement to show you understand it and accept it. It is then returned to school.

The school will:

- ❖ Provide a high standard of education for all of its pupils as set out in its Mission Statement and aims.
- ❖ Contact you if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality. Recognise and celebrate good attendance.
- ❖ Let you know if there are any concerns that affect your child's work or behaviour.
- ❖ Inform you of your child's progress through parent's meetings and their end of year report.
- ❖ Reward achievement through the school's award system.
- ❖ Keep you informed about school activities through newsletters and notices about special events.

The Parents

I / We will:

- ❖ Support and promote the school's aims and values with my/our child.
- ❖ Ensure that my child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped in school uniform.
- ❖ If my child is absent I / we will inform the school promptly.
- ❖ Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- ❖ Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities and newsletters.
- ❖ Encourage my child to work hard and to the best of his/her ability.
- ❖ Support my child in homework tasks and opportunities for home learning and praise his/her efforts.
- ❖ Support the school's pastoral care and discipline policies as set out on the school website.
- ❖ Attend parental consultation evenings to discuss my child's progress.
- ❖ I / we have read the Parent Contract which can be found on the school website and agree to the content.

- ❖ Make sure that my homework is completed on time.
