National Assessments

Next week, the **Year 1** children will be completing their Phonics Check with Mrs Prytherch. Each child completes the check on a 1:1 basis. We will let parents know, in the school report, if each child met the required standard. In the past, this has been 32 words correct out of 40.

Year 4 will be completing the national Multiplication Tables Check next week. It is really important that they keep practising the X tables at home! TT Rock Stars is ideal for this.

I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week.

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.

Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.

The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.
